The Latina Leadership Program facilitates women's leadership development and community activism. The 15-week program empowers participants to recognize their strengths and build their leadership abilities, assertiveness, and self-perceived skills as an agent of change.

Discussions center around cultural factors that may represent challenges to personal development and how the political, social, governmental, and court system works. The program focuses on issues that affect the community such as immigration, health, women's rights, gender violence, education and political reform.

The program was created in 1988 in response to the need of women who had received services and wanted to stay connected to the agency in a more healthy way.

Latina Leadership moved women from being victims to taking charge of their lives and becoming leaders in their community.
